Don't forget the selfie in front of the sign

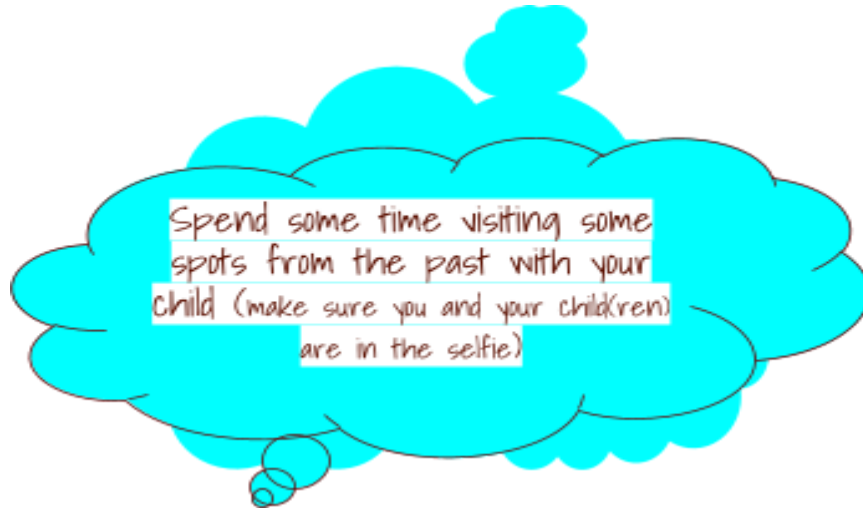
